ACTION ITEMS

- **Approval of Minutes**
Motion to approve minutes from December 3, 2025, by Councilwoman Oglesby, seconded by Councilman Breish. Motion passes 2-0.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS/DEPARTMENT UPDATES

- **North Penn Valley Girls Softball Association (NPVGSA) – Tournament and Field Request**
NPVGSA is requesting to once again host 12 tournaments and the use of four fields for events. This same request was approved in 2025, and there were no reported complaints or issues. The Parks and Recreation Department will approve this request.
- **Comprehensive Park, Recreation, and Open Space Plan Update**
The consultant is currently conducting individual stakeholder interviews and focus group discussions. The next committee meeting is scheduled for March 19. The next public meeting will be held prior to Memorial Day.
- **White's Road Park Pool Update**
The contractor is preparing the installation of the filter room. Staff are coordinating with the electric subcontractor for deck lighting and audio. Trees that were removed as part of the construction process will be replaced in the fall at suitable locations within the park. Junior Council Person Anna Szekely, drawing on her experience working at the pool, supports the replacements for their shade and environmental benefits.

- **Liberty Bell Trail Phase III Update**

This project is currently out to bid, with bids due Thursday, April 9. Pending receipt of bids and formal award, the engineer anticipates issuing a notice to proceed in early July.

- **White's Road Pool Building Front Exterior Mural**

The art teacher at Lansdale Catholic has provided updated drafts for the front exterior mural for the White's Road Pool Building. This project will be completed by art students at no cost to the Borough. Councilwoman Oglesby has agreed to prepare a mock-up for the students to reference when finalizing the design.
